
EFFECTIVE OCTOBER 2, 2023, THE CITY OF GROVETON WILL IMPLEMENT STAGE 1 OF THE DROUGHT CONTINGENCY PLAN.

Voluntary Water Use Restrictions:

(a) Water customers are requested to voluntarily limit the irrigation of landscape areas to Sunday and Thursday for customers with a street address ending in even number (0, 2, 4, 6, or 8) and Saturday and Wednesday for water customers with a street address ending in odd number (1, 3, 5, 7, or 9), and to irrigate landscapes only between the hours of 6:00 a.m. to 10:00 a.m. and 8:00 p.m. to midnight on designated watering days.

Water customers are requested to practice water (b) conservation and to minimize or discontinue water use for non-essential purposes.

Non-Essential Water Use: Water uses that are not essential or required for the protection of public health, safety, and welfare including:

- (a) Irrigation of landscape areas, including parks, athletic fields, and golf courses, except otherwise provided under this plan;
- Use of water to wash down any sidewalks, walkways, **(b)** driveways, parking lots, or other hard surfaced areas;
- Use of water to wash any motor vehicle, motorbike, boat, (c) trailer, or other vehicle;
- Use of water to wash down buildings or structures for (d) purposes other than immediate fire protection;
- Flushing gutters or permitting water to run or accumulate in (e) any gutter or street;
- **(f)** Use of water to fill, refill, or add to any indoor or outdoor swimming pools or Jacuzzi type pools;
- Use of water in a fountain or pond for aesthetic or scenic **(g)** purposes except where necessary to support aquatic life;
- Failure to repair a controllable leak(s) within a reasonable (h) period after having been given notice directing the repair of such leak(s); and
- **(i)** Use of water from hydrants for construction purposes or any other purposes other than fire-fighting.
