NOTICE TO CITY OF GROVETON WATER CUSTOMERS

EMERGENCY WATER SHORTAGE HAS BEEN TERMINATED.

**EFFECTIVE OCTOBER 2, 2023, THE
CITY OF GROVETON WILL IMPLEMENT
STAGE 1 OF THE DROUGHT
CONTINGENCY PLAN.**

Voluntary Water Use Restrictions:

- (a) Water customers are requested to voluntarily limit the irrigation of landscape areas to Sunday and Thursday for customers with a street address ending in even number (0, 2, 4, 6, or 8) and Saturday and Wednesday for water customers with a street address ending in odd number (1, 3, 5, 7, or 9), and to irrigate landscapes only between the hours of 6:00 a.m. to 10:00 a.m. and 8:00 p.m. to midnight on designated watering days.

- (b) Water customers are requested to practice water conservation and to minimize or discontinue water use for non-essential purposes.**

Non-Essential Water Use: Water uses that are not essential or required for the protection of public health, safety, and welfare including:

- (a) Irrigation of landscape areas, including parks, athletic fields, and golf courses, except otherwise provided under this plan;**
- (b) Use of water to wash down any sidewalks, walkways, driveways, parking lots, or other hard surfaced areas;**
- (c) Use of water to wash any motor vehicle, motorbike, boat, trailer, or other vehicle;**
- (d) Use of water to wash down buildings or structures for purposes other than immediate fire protection;**
- (e) Flushing gutters or permitting water to run or accumulate in any gutter or street;**
- (f) Use of water to fill, refill, or add to any indoor or outdoor swimming pools or Jacuzzi type pools;**
- (g) Use of water in a fountain or pond for aesthetic or scenic purposes except where necessary to support aquatic life;**
- (h) Failure to repair a controllable leak(s) within a reasonable period after having been given notice directing the repair of such leak(s); and**
- (i) Use of water from hydrants for construction purposes or any other purposes other than fire-fighting.**
